Up to this point, we have earned the sweepstakes award at all of our SCSBOA competitions. I know it is a long drive, but it is so worth it to see the band and color guard in their final hour. It costs \$12 to get in. Please sit together as a Warren cheering section and show your pride.

### **Awards Etiquette:**

If we medal, I request that parents stay off the field while we are handing out medals and taking our group pictures. Once that is complete you can join us on the field, celebrate with us and take pictures. Please be respectful of the other bands that medal as well. Not all stadiums will allow spectators to enter the field, if this is the rule we thank you for being respectful. I encourage you to wear comfortable shoes that are not heels. Often times heels are not welcome on turf fields.

## **Student Notes:**

1. Make sure you eat breakfast and lunch today.
2. Bring extra reeds, valve oil, slide grease and a positive mental attitude and the desire to want to do your best!
3. DO NOT WEAR jewelry, finger nail polish, make-up, perfume, cologne, etc. Have your hair up and ready to go.
4. Money for concessions – you will be eating dinner at the concession stand.
5. We will stay in full uniform through awards. Please bring your sweater/jackets with you to warm up and performance so you can put them back on when we finish performing. You might want to also have your cell phone in your jacket pocket so you can take pictures if we medal.

### **WHAT TO WEAR:**

Wear your class B (blue jeans and polo shirt). You MUST be wearing your under armor underneath your class B. YOU WILL be changing in public. It helps if you are wearing your black socks so you are ready to go. Have your hair already pinned up! Only Warren hats and beanies allowed on this trip.

### **WHAT TO BRING:**

1. Marching Shoes - polished
2. Solid Black Calf length socks.
3. Black gloves – precut the fingers out if you play clarinet or open holed flute
5. Band jacket or sweater
6. Cash to eat at concession stand

### **Awards Protocol (if we earn a medal)**

1. Students will form a parade block in an orderly respectful manner. Students will stand at “stand by” while medals are given out.
2. Head leadership will put plaque in front of band and stand next to it. Niemeyer will give them their medals.
3. Guard will stand behind head leadership in block formation. Staff will give out medals
4. Winds/Percussion will stand behind guard in parade block formation. Staff will give out medals
5. After Medals are distributed – pictures begin
  - a. Head Leadership with plaque
  - b. Section Leaders with plaque
  - c. Guard with plaque
  - d. Percussion with plaque
  - e. Senior Class with plaque
  - f. Whole group with plaque
  - g. Any other section with plaque
6. Once this is done, parents are welcome to join us on the field and take more pictures and celebrate.
7. If we earn gold and the host allows, we will give a victory concert.
8. We will celebrate with cake, apple cider, etc. by our trailers after awards no matter the outcome.
