EXPECTATIONS

While On Bus:

1. Your voice should not be heard outside the seat you are seating in.
2. Windows should be kept half way up.
3. Never put your hands or any objects out windows.
4. Be silent at Rail Road Crossings.
5. Sit facing forward the entire time.
6. Help clean up and pick up.
7. Say thank you to bus driver.

While in theatre:

1. Sit properly in your seat – do not put your feet up.
2. No food or gum.
3. Keep cell phones and other electronics silent or off.
4. Do not talk, whisper, text etc during a group's performance.
5. Use the restroom in between performing groups, not during.
6. Ok to talk, text etc when group is not on stage. Once a group is walking on stage – everything else stops.

While in Warm Up, Performance, Sight Reading:

1. Be mature and remain respectful of those working the event and their rules.
2. Remain silent – this isn't the time to fix things or talk about your feelings.
3. Sit tall, make great music.
4. Enjoy your performance, how many more times are you going to get this opportunity?
5. Remain positive even if things get stressful.

Overall:

1. Be thankful to the parent volunteers...thank them for their time and respect them.
2. Fill out your festival critiques with your own words and thoughts, not your friends.
3. Be a kind, considerate, cooperative individual and team player.
